Victoria's Department of Justice has awarded a contract to Aspect to commission twenty-two fixed speed enforcement systems on Melbourne's newest motorway - EastLink.

Aspect has used a similar solution to that used on Melbourne's Western Ring Road where Aspect supplied more than twenty such systems.

Including CityLink, this will bring to more than fifty the number of parabolic radar systems commissioned by Aspect Traffic.



Queensland's first point-to-point speed enforcement system



Aspect Traffic completes the first digital enforcement project for Queensland.

This innovative system utilizes a PIPS Technology ANPR solution and Aspect software to encourage heavy goods vehicles to use a nearby motorway system rather than the alternative suburban route. Aspect's system records an image of all vehicles, regardless of size or type and matches number plate reads to determine a vehicle's speed measurement over the route as well as the type of vehicle recorded.

Aspect scores a major digital camera upgrade program

Aspect Traffic has secured a contract with Serco Australia to supply more than sixty Gatsometer GS11 digital cameras for Victoria's mobile speed enforcement fleet.

These GS11 eleven megapixel (11MP) digital camera systems will be installed in a fleet of more than sixty vehicles that will continue to use the existing Gatsometer radar.

This breakthrough will bring an end to wet film camera use in Victoria and will enable more efficient infringement processing.

The Gatso GS11 covers up to six lanes of traffic, is far easier to use than a wet-film camera and provides greater reliability in field operations. Gatso's GS11 has a



simple operator interface, allows test shots to be taken and viewed at any time and has the highest available encryption standards.

As part of this contract, Aspect has also been commissioned to upgrade fixed speed cameras in CityLink's Burnley Tunnel using Gatsometer DRCS-P systems.
